



## Eligibility

**To be eligible for the rebate you must meet the following requirements:**

- ✓ You must have the legal authority to modify the trucks and/or trailers identified in your rebate application;
- ✓ You must represent an Alberta company that operates vehicles base-plated in Alberta with a gross vehicle weight rating of 7,258 kg or greater (16,000 lbs or Class 5 to Class 8) in Alberta ;
- ✓ You must purchase and install fuel efficiency equipment from our list of [Current Eligible Equipment](#) between June 1, 2010 and December 31, 2011;
- ✓ Equipment must be installed on a commercial vehicle or trailer base-plated in Alberta and whose registration is valid as of the date of application; and
- ✓ Coolant heaters (hydronic heaters) must be installed in such a way that they bring heat into the cab while the engine is off.

## Information

**In order to process your application for rebate payment, we require the following information:**

- ✓ Manufacturer and model number of fuel efficiency equipment installed;
- ✓ Registration number and VIN of all vehicles or trailers onto which fuel efficiency equipment is installed;
- ✓ Applicant's name, company name, company address, phone number and email address; and
- ✓ Alberta business number of applicant's company.

## Documentation

**In order to process your application, we require a copy of the purchase receipt and installation documentation. The following information MUST be clearly indicated:**

The following application terms and conditions (“Application Terms and Conditions”) establish the eligibility requirements and related terms and conditions for an application to Trucks of Tomorrow (“Program”). The application shall be subject to approval by Climate Change Central. A completed application is not a guarantee of eligibility for a rebate under the Program nor payment of the rebate itself and is subject to the following Application Terms and Conditions.

1. Program eligibility requires that the Applicant PURCHASE and INSTALL eligible fuel efficiency equipment (except in the case of hybrid drivetrains, which need not be installed), onto vehicles with a gvwr of 7,258 Kg or greater (16,000 lbs, Class 5-8) commercial vehicles or trailers owned and base-plated in Alberta under the name of an Alberta company between the dates of **May 31, 2010 and December 31, 2011**. 2. Applicants are responsible for researching and ensuring they qualify under applicable eligibility criteria and Applicants hereby indemnify Climate Change Central against any liability for the same.
3. The following information **MUST** be clearly indicated on the purchase receipt:
  - a. Applicant’s name (company name). Applicant company **MUST** be the purchaser;
  - b. Purchase price **MUST** be indicated on the receipt;
  - c. Purchase date;
  - d. Make and model of energy efficiency equipment;
  - e. Proof that invoice was paid in full;
  - f. Business address from which the fuel efficiency equipment, vehicle and or installation was purchased.
4. The application **MUST** include the Vehicle Identification Number or serial number of vehicle or trailer, respectively, onto which fuel efficiency equipment was installed;
5. Copies of the application form, purchase receipts, installation documentation and vehicle registration are required to process applications. Omission of required information will result in an incomplete application. Climate Change Central accepts no responsibility for incomplete, lost, or misdirected mail or illegible submissions.
6. Rebates are limited to a company maximum of \$30,000 (not including Hybrid drive trains).
7. Agricultural machinery and construction equipment other than trucks do not qualify. That includes combines, front-end loaders, farm tractors, bobcats and bulldozers and any other equipment not primarily intended for the road.
8. A maximum of one (1) hybrid rebate will be awarded per company.
9. Any other rebate(s), discount(s) and/or incentive(s) offered and/or provided by any government agency, institution, manufacturer, distributor, dealer and/or installer are separate and distinct from the Program and Climate Change Central shall not be responsible for the administration or payment of the other programs or be responsible for the erroneous submission of other rebate(s), discount(s), and/or incentive(s) to Climate Change Central.
10. The Applicant is responsible for meeting all Program requirements and complying with any laws, regulations or by-laws regarding permits, codes, restrictions and/or inspections in relation to vehicles, products, or equipment installed. The Applicant shall be responsible for any direct or indirect taxes, duties, levies or fees or like charges incurred by Applicant as a result of participation in the Program and hereby indemnifies Climate Change Central for the same.
11. The Applicant agrees that it is solely responsible for and liable for the selection, purchase, registration and ownership/maintenance of the fuel efficiency equipment and/or vehicles listed in the application form and that Climate Change Central is not affiliated in any way with the manufacturer, distributor and/or dealer of the fuel efficiency equipment and/or vehicles. The Applicant acknowledges and agrees that Climate Change Central makes no representation or warranty, whether expressed, implied, direct or indirect with respect to the vehicles, fuel efficiency equipment, services or other measures that the Applicant has purchased and which is the subject matter of the rebate application. The Applicant further acknowledges that Climate Change Central is not responsible for the design, verification, operation or implementation of the vehicles and/or fuel efficiency equipment nor the performance of vehicles and/or fuel efficiency equipment and that Climate Change Central accepts no liability nor makes any representations with respect to estimated or possible fuel and/or maintenance savings that will be incurred in the operation of the fuel efficiency equipment, vehicle, services or measures, and/or the performance, reliability, safety, use or fitness of the fuel efficiency equipment or vehicles for the Applicant’s particular purpose.
12. In submitting this application, the Applicant consents to the collection and use, disclosure and retention of the personal information herein provided in accordance with these Application Terms and Conditions.
13. The Applicant consents to the disclosure of information to Climate Change Central and its contractors, employees and partners including but not limited to the Government of Alberta for purposes of eligibility verification, complementary rebates and possible issuance of a rebate cheque to the Applicant.
14. The Applicant consents to Climate Change Central using the information provided in the application to complete a follow-up survey of the Applicant to gauge the success of the Program and acknowledges that Climate Change Central reserves the right to conduct field inspections to verify fuel efficiency equipment and/or vehicles’ registration and compliance with the Application Terms and Conditions.
15. The Applicant consents to the retention of Applicant’s contact information for five years following which such information will be destroyed or made anonymous. Climate Change Central undertakes that the information provided in this application will not be sold or distributed for commercial or promotional purposes or financial gain.
16. Climate Change Central reserves the right to change or terminate the Program at any time without notice or explanation. Climate Change Central will use reasonable efforts to administer a completed eligible application received prior to such a change or termination of the Program in accordance with the Program as it existed effective as of the date of the completed eligible application.
17. Applicant should retain a copy of its application as Applicant’s original application and purchase receipt will not be returned by Climate Change Central.
18. Applicant should allow at least **eight weeks** to administer the application and, if approved, for the issuance of a rebate cheque. All rebate cheques **MUST** be cashed within **180 days** from the cheque’s issuance date and will **NOT** be re-issued after this time.
